
Neighborhood Trivia

Neighborhood Updates

The community met our required goal to cover the construction costs for ETC to install fiber in our neighborhood. Fiber will bring high speed internet and TV which will greatly benefit our safety, entertainment, work and increase our home values.

ETC Engineering has begun working on the project and will provide a schedule for starting and completion and will also coordinate the marking of the <u>public</u> utilities. We estimate that they will finish around February 2021. *Note, the HOA will be responsible marking and any repairs of the* <u>main</u> water lines only. Owners will be responsible for marking their own water supply lines. Please read any emails regarding this project as they come out.

Home Maintenance Reminders

Check your batteries! Even if your smoke detectors are hard wired be sure to change the batteries every 6 months! Be sure you replace the entire detector every 10 years! If you do not have a Carbon Monoxide Detectors – consider installing some as well.

Hot water tanks (and tankless heaters) need maintenance! To prolong the life of your hot water tank you should drain and clean out any sediment that has collected once a year. Be sure to check your anode rod every couple of years and replace before it is completely gone. This can easily be done on your own or by a local plumber.

Fall is here, be sure to get your fireplace and furnace inspected and cleaned before those cold nights are upon us.

Gravel for driveways can be purchased at the North Georgia Co-Op or from Simmons Grading. Prices and Delivery options vary.

Be sure to protect your house before we get our first hard freeze. Shut off any outside hose bibs from the inside if possible, drain and cover with an insulated cover. If you are not living here full time, consider shutting off water to your house at the road and drain your plumbing. You can also ask a neighbor to drip your faucets while you are away!

There is a lot of wildlife to enjoy in our neighborhood like Bears, Coyotes, Bobcats, Turkey, Deer and more. Most of these animals are attracted to birdseed, trash and food scraps. Please follow the advice from https://georgiawildlife.com/preventing-wildlife-conflicts on how to reduce any potential problems.
